Results and questions

You can call us every day if you have any questions, for example with regard to lab results. Call us in the morning; we discuss your question with the general practitioners the same day and will ask you to call us back so that we can give you a correct answer.

We ask for your understanding and patience.

Doctor's consultation hour

The doctors' consultations are held every working day. You should always first make an appointment. You can call the GP for an appointment on working days between 8-10 am. You cannot make an appointment after 10 am!

When making an appointment, the assistant will ask for the reason. She is trained to do so and does so in order to make the best possible estimate of the nature and urgency of your complaints. The assistant is (just like the general practitioner) bound by confidentiality.

Do you have multiple complaints or questions? Please mention that, so we can give you a double appointment.

If it is not possible to come to the practice yourself, the doctor can also visit you at home. Together with the doctor, the assistant assesses whether a home visit is to be made. The home visit is not intended for people who don't have time or no transportation to come to the practice.

Assistants consultation hour

Our assistants have their own consultation hour every day. They are trained to do so. You can call between 8 am and 10 am every morning to make an appointment with the assistants. What they do is:

- Measuring bloodpressure
- injections / vaccinations
- CRP / sugar prick
- ear syringing
- binding wounds
- removing stitches
- urinalysis
- smears
- warts treatment

Nurses (POH's)

We have nurses in our practice to complement our doctors, so the latter can focus as much as possible on diagnosing and treating your complaints

The nurses take care of chronic diseases or, for example, age related complaints, diabetes, cardiovascular diseases (CVRM), lung diseases and psychological complaints. They work in close contact with our GPs and regularly consult them.

House rules

In order to keep our practice fine and safe for us all, we do apply the following rules.

- Emergencies come first.
- We treat each other with respect and do not insult each other.
- We do not tolerate discrimination, aggression, violence, and unwanted (sexually) harassing behavior in any form.
- People who are under the influence of alcohol and / or drugs may be denied access to the practice.
- Respect the privacy of our patients and staff; so do not make videos or photos.
- Mobile calling is allowed, but respect each others privacy.
- With the exception of assistance dogs, animals are not allowed.
- The GP or staff is not liable for damage, loss or theft.
- If our rules are violated, we will report it tot the police. We may also deny you access to the practice.
